

Draft Revision to AS/NZS ISO 8124.2:2003

The Joint Standards Australia/Standards New Zealand Committee CS-018 (Safety of Toys) has prepared a **Draft Standard (DR 08228 CP)** for the revision of **AS/NZS ISO 8124.2:2003 – Safety of toys – Part 2: Flammability**. This draft standard (DR 08228 CP) was opened for public comment from 24 December, 2008 till 4 February, 2009.



This draft standard (DR 08228 CP) was identical with, and reproduced from the international standard **ISO 8124-2:2007 Safety of toys, Part 2: Flammability**. Compared with the existing standard **AS/NZS ISO 8124.2:2003**, the key changes are summarized into the following table.

Section (Requirement)	Key Changes in the Draft Standard (DR 08228 CP)
4.1 General requirements	Add " Highly flammable solids " and " flammable gels ", and delete " extremely flammable liquid " and " flammable solids " in the prohibited list of materials for manufacturing toys.
4.2 Toys to be worn on the head	Reorganize this section and categorize it into 5 sub-sections: 4.2.1 General (a new requirement) 4.2.2 Beards, moustaches, wigs, etc. made from hair, pile or material with similar features (e.g., free-hanging ribbons, paper or cloth strands), which protrude more than or equal to 50 mm from the surface of the toy 4.2.3 Beards, moustaches, wigs, etc., made from hair, pile or material with similar features (e.g., free-hanging ribbons, paper or cloth strands), which protrude less than 50 mm from the surface of the toy 4.2.4 Full or partially molded head masks 4.2.5 Flowing elements of toys to be worn on the head (a new requirement)
4.5 Soft-filled toys (animals and dolls, etc.) with a piled or textile surface	Classify the soft-filled toys in terms of their maximum dimensions, and then follow through different sections for the test method. 4.5.1 General 4.5.2 Soft-filled toys with a maximum dimension of 520 mm or less 4.5.3 Soft-filled toys with a maximum dimension greater than 520 mm
Remark: If it is not possible to obtain test sample from a single toy, selective requirements such as 4.2.5 (Flowing elements of toys to be worn on the head) , 4.3 (Toy disguise costumes and toys intended to be worn by a child in a play) and 4.4 (Toys intended to be entered by a child) do not apply.
